

## **AUGE Sub-Committee Meeting 10 January 2020**

### **Summary of Key Messages**

- **Data**

- The AUGE will put together a new request for data regarding TRAS outliers and ETTOS leads. This request will be made before the next TIG meeting on 21<sup>st</sup> January.
- Theft data and calculations will be provided to the industry on UK Link Secure Documentation.

- **Analysis**

- The AUGE will raise a change control with the CDSP for the LDZ-level factors work. This work will provide the information required by the industry to decide whether to proceed with this development.
- The AUGE will provide a paper on using different UIG factors for allocation and reconciliation.

- **Industry Issues and Modifications**

- It will not be possible for the CDSP to implement the necessary system changes to handle UIG factors split by new EUC bands in time for the 2020/21 gas year.
- The CDSP will restart the process of procuring a gas temperature lab study.
- Movement of sites to Product Class 1 as a result of Mod665 is progressing. This should be complete for the next data extraction, which will be used for the calculation of the final UIG factors.
- The potential for separating out the Volume Conversion component of UIG in order to encourage use of converters is seen as a positive step, and this will be discussed at PAC.
