A3: Proposer Requirements / Final (redlined) Change

<p>Problem Statement:</p>	<p>Fax relies on the Public Switched Telephone Network (PSTN), which is in the process of being switched off and migrated to an all-IP network. By 2025, all equipment that uses PSTN, including fax, will cease to work.</p> <p>A Modification is being raised by National Gas Transmission (NGT) which seeks to update references to facsimile within the UNC. There is also expected to be an equivalent Modification in IGT Code to do the same.</p> <p>As facsimile is currently a Code Communication and is referenced in UNC and IGT UNC, there are several processes, files and reports that could include this as a communication method and data item..</p> <p>With the facsimile being proposed to be updated within UNC (and IGT UNC), through the Modifications due to be raised (ref numbers TBC), and the decommissioning of the PSTN, all references to 'facsimile' within central systems and process must be identified and assessed in terms how these should be managed.</p>	
<p>Change Description:</p>	<p>This Change Proposal has been raised to identify any references to 'facsimile' within CDSP systems, processes and documentation. Currently there are processes which request fax numbers from customers and therefore there are fields within certain files and documentation that will be inapplicable following the Modification and ultimately, decommissioning of PSTN.</p> <p>Fax is included as an allowable value in certain UK Link files and where there are instances of it being received into the UK Link database, an assessment is needed to consider how this should be managed in terms of fax being updated in UNC and being decommissioned.</p> <p>In instances where fax is listed as the only form of communication, this must be identified, and a suitable alternative introduced to ensure no interruption to any ongoing services.</p>
