The first Negative Consumption Report was issued on 27th of June. The report will inform the inbound and outbound Shippers of the presence of negative consumption, either pre or post a Shipper Transfer, Class Change or Re-Confirmation.

The Negative Consumption Report will be delivered to Shippers monthly, reporting on the previous months read submissions that have resulted in a negative consumption being generated. The Negative Consumption Report comprises two spreadsheets – one where the Shipper is the current Shipper and

one where they are the previous Shipper; the current shipper spreadsheet will contain two tabs (details of which are shown below), while the losing Shipper spreadsheet will only contain Tab 2:

- Tab 1: Tab 1: This will highlight negative consumption(s) against a read following an estimated read.
- Tab 2: Tab 2: This will highlight negative consumption(s) against a read following an actual read.

The new Negative Consumption report will be delivered to Shippers via the Reads & AQ Team utilising the aqq.spa@xoserve.com e-mail address and will be issued to both the inbound and outbound Shippers.

The report contains the negative consumption values received in the preceding month and will be issued on the next working day after the 25th of the month. The purpose of the report is to highlight to Shippers where negative consumption is recorded within UK Link, so that potential corrective action can be undertaken to update the negative position. If Shippers wish to take any actions to address any negative consumption highlighted within the report, the remedy options are as follows:

- The replacement of an Xoserve generated estimated Meter Read(s)
- The replacement of an Actual Read(s), or
- The submission of a Consumption Adjustment

The corrective action taken will maximise the volume of new AQ calculations and ensure a SMPs current AQ value is in line with its current consumption, not just a historical consumption position
