

Potential clause to be added in each case where facsimile is removed (and replaced with email where email is currently not referenced):

“Notwithstanding any other provision of the Code the relevant Parties may by exception agree to an alternative method of communication and any such agreement not to be unreasonably withheld or delayed.”

By agreement between Parties - supporting UNC references:

- TPD-G 2.4.7: “unless otherwise agreed between the Transporter and the Registered User”.
- TPD-S 1.8.3 “(or any other period agreed between the Transporter and the User)”.
- OAD, Section M 2.21: “by any other specific medium and/or communications system described in the Offtake Communications Document”.
- TPD Section B 8.1.6 (b): “in such manner as may be agreed between the DN Operator and the Registered User”.

Not unreasonably withheld - supporting UNC references:

- GTA 2.4.5: “they may engage such adviser with the consent of the parties (which consent shall not be unreasonably withheld)”
- GTB 6.1.1: “subject to paragraph 6.1.6, with the prior agreement in writing of each relevant other Party, which shall not unreasonably be withheld, to any person.”
- TPD-G 2.4.6: “provided that the Transporter will not undertake such works without first obtaining the consent (not to be unreasonably withheld) of the Registered User of each Supply Point”
