The Workgroup Report is due to be presented at the UNC Modification Panel by 18 April 2019.

1.0 Outline of Modification

Ellie Rogers (ER) introduced the Modification and explained the background highlighting that Meter Asset Provider (MAP) identity is required to be added to the meter point data in UK Link in order to facilitate the submission of Central Switching Systems notices.

This change is required to add MAP as a new User type to the Data Permissions Matrix (DPM) in line with the code set out in Modification 0649S. This will then enable a request for the disclosure of specific data to be submitted to the DSC Contract Management Committee for approval, to support the data cleansing and population of the accurate MAP Id in UK Link systems for onward transmission to CSS.

ER explained that the only option being considered is the addition of the MAP as a new User type to the DPM.

It was also noted that a further IGT and UNC Modifications would be needed to clarify this type of User type change and make the whole data request process easier to understand from a code perspective
