When NW offered (should the need arise) to provide supporting statements for inclusion within the Workgroup Sections 6 and 7 primarily, EF pointed out that whilst this would be helpful (as a good starting point), the Workgroup Report is intended to represent the views of all Workgroup participants and not simply the Proposer's views.
