	New paragraph 2.2.1(c)	Establishes a new basis on which the classification of a Supply Meter Point or Supply Point can be changed - i.e. by the CDSP per the 691S solution.
	New paragraph 2.2.6	Establishes requirement on CDSP to monitor AQ at Supply Meter Points and notify relevant stakeholders when AQ goes beyond Class 1 threshold in 2.1.3(b). Cross reference made to the process through which CDSP informs shippers (2.3.6). Equivalent language to that in 2.3.6 adopted and repeated to create a new duty on CDSP to inform Transporter and DM Services Provider.
	New paragraph 2.2.7	Establishes the initial steps the CDSP must take if it believes a Registered User has failed to reclassify a Supply Meter Point into Class 1.
	New paragraph 2.2.8	Establishes a requirement on CDSP to reclassify a Supply Meter Point into Class 1 where Registered User has failed to act within grace period established under 2.2.7, and explains what information CDSP will adopt when doing so. The information to be adopted also covers default provisions applicable in cases where the Registered User does not provide information or provides information that fails validation.
	New paragraph 2.2.9	Establishes a requirement on Registered User to cooperate in all necessary steps to facilitate: (a) the installation of Transporter Daily Read Equipment; and (b) the reclassification of the Supply Meter Point pursuant to 2.2.8 should further assistance be required by CDSP or other UNC Party.
	New paragraph 2.2.10	Clarifies that: (a) Registered User remains responsible for effects arising from its failure to reclassify; and (b) responsibility for details included by the CDSP when intervening to ensure a reclassification occurs are to be

		treated as if they had been made by the Registered User.
