5. Review of Outstanding Actions

Action 1201: Xoserve to understand what direction the Proposer wants to go with this and complete an impact and implementation assessment.

Update: SM advised that he has added Business Rule 3 to the Modification which has been reviewed by the Legal Text provider. AR showed onscreen the proposed amendments made to Modification 0696 with new Business Rule 3.

Upon discussing the changes to be made to the Modification the following points were raised by Workgroup:

DA commented on the changes and advised how this would be problematic in regard to data fixes. The issue is that, without any system changes, the SOQ will have to be data-fixed down to the ratchetted value.

Further discussions took place around this rule and how this will be delivered. AR suggested if that is the rule SM wants then this should be proposed and implementation would have to be resolved at future Workgroup discussions. DA said that to implement this rule, a system change (adding an input screen in UK-Link systems), would be the minimum requirement to prevent the need for data fixes).

DA clarified that, each time the SOQ is increased, there would need to be a data fix for each ratchet where the SOQ ratcheted above the capped value, if no system fix is implemented.

DA advised the Workgroup that the Xoserve technical team are looking to introduce an Xoserve only screen which will be relatively easy to implement. This will capture and eventualities where the system needs to override the existing SOQ derivation value.

RP clarified a that the proposal was that Site would only be charged the highest ratchet charge in any month.

SM will add an explicit statement to the Business Rules, for clarity, with reference to a monthly calculation as the relevant billing period, in accordance with B4.7.13.

During Workgroup discussions, reference was made to UNC TPD G 5.5.2 and B 4.7.13 with the suggestion that B 4.7.13 may require amendment. **Carried Forward**

New Action 0101: Joint Office to raise a ROM once the Variation Request is received.

Action 1202: RP to revise the Legal Text.

Update: RP agreed to provide the legal text based on the revised Business Rules. Closed

Action 1203: SM to write the new Business Rule to accommodate the Ratchet element

Update: This has been completed although further amendment to the Business Rules is required, which is captured as part of these minutes. **Closed**

Action 1204: All Workgroup participants to review the Supplemental Report that AR has drafted.

Update: This has been drafted and is available for review and comment. Closed
