The Workgroup Report is due to be presented at the UNC Modification Panel by 21 May 2020.

1.0 Outline of Modification

PL introduced the Modification and explained that adding a new User type to the Data Permissions Matrix (DPM) requires a modification. He went on to explain on the 01 April 2019 National Grid Electricity System Operator (NG ESO) was established as a separate legal entity within the National Grid Group.

Electricity System Operator is not currently a 'User type' in the DPM, as under the existing arrangements only, National Grid is party to the Data Services Contract (DSC).

National Grid ESO produces the Future Energy Scenarios (FES) and Electricity Ten Year Statement (ETYS) annual reports which map out credible pathways and scenarios for the future of energy. These reports use data held by the CDSP, accessed by way of permissions set out in the DPM.

The addition of the new User type would enable National Grid ESO to request access to specific information held by the CDSP to facilitate relevant analysis to enable the continued production of the FES/ETYS reports.

2.0 Initial Discussion

2.1. Issues and Questions from Panel

2.1.1.Consider what data is already available and whether the ESO addition to DPM still needs to be progressed

Workgroup agreed that the addition of ESO to the DPM is required.

2.1.2. Consider if a change to UNC TPD Section V5 is required

Workgroup considered the panel question and concluded that all User types will be in code as well as DPM. For the avoidance of doubt Workgroup agreed that ESO needs to be added to the code.

In light of the knowledge that other user types are listed in code; PL accepts this change also needs to be included in code.

AR advised that an amended Modification is now required to clarify the code changes to section V5 and, as this Modification is linked to a specific purpose, (FES), it may need to be made more generic.

It was recognised that a similar IGT Modification would need to be raised. Joint Office have notified the IGT Panel chair that this is the case.
