Ofordi Nabokei (ON) advised that from NGT's perspective, some work would need to be done in terms of the analysis of how far the oxygen would go into the system. ON noted that NGT does not expect it to be too much of an issue and NGT is doing its own penetration analysis work.

EF referred to the Heat Maps that were provided with [Modification 0712S](#) and noted that the maps provided a good analysis of how far the gas was getting in and asked whether ON is expecting to see something similar. ON confirmed that they expect to see something similar. EF highlighted that people may want to think about whether they have plants that would be affected by it.
